## EMS COVID-19 Non-Transport Protocol

<u>Purpose</u>: To identify patients who can safely be managed for symptoms of COVID-19 without EMS transport to an ED.

<u>Background</u>: The ongoing COVID-19 global pandemic has the potential to severely stress local healthcare systems and deplete valuable resources. During this pandemic it is appropriate for EMS providers to assist in ensuring patients with respiratory complaints suggestive of COVID-19 infection receive appropriate guidance and education in an attempt to reserve higher levels of care for those most in need. EMS clinician practice should be based on the most up-to-date recommendations, including information from local health systems, public health authorities, and EMS medical direction.
